IT IS FINISHED.

- A. The end of the prophecies concerning Christ (Dan. 9:24; Jn. 5:39; Lk. 24:44).
- B. The end of the Law of Moses and the Levitical sacrificial system (Mt. 5:17-18; Heb. 10:11-14; Dan. 9:27; 1Jn. 2:1-2; Col. 2:14).
- C. The end of the Jew/Gentile division (Eph. 2:14-16; Rom. 11:17-21).
- D. The end of the Sabbath and other special days (Col. 2:16-17; Rom. 14:5-6; Gal. 4:10-11).
- E. The end (or fruition) of God's atonement in Christ (Heb. 9:24-26; Eph. 1:8b-12).
- F. The end of the unlimited power of Satan (Heb. 2:14-15; Jn. 12:31; Rev. 20:2-3; 1Jn. 3:8; Lk. 10:18; 11:21-23).
- G. The end of the earthly, personal ministry of Jesus (Mt. 16:21; Jn. 16:16-20).
