- A. Scripture text: 1Corinthians 2:6-9.
- B. Tonight I would like for you to think of men as a real estate salesman, because I have 2 pieces of property that you might be interested in. I'm not the seller of these places of abode, but can offer them to you just the same.
- C. After I have described them to you please feel free to choose the one you like the most. If you have further questions please see me afterwards.

### I. THE FIRST PIECE OF PROPERTY.

A. As I look into my real estate brochure, I see some information you may be interested in.

## B. <u>First</u>, the neighborhood.

It consists of something quite dark, even gloomy. Second Peter 2:4 doesn't think much of this place, calling it a pit.

# C. <u>Second</u>, the neighbors.

The folks around you are not all that friendly; they spend most of their time weeping and gnashing their teeth (Mt. 8:12).

# D. <u>Third</u>, occupation of the people.

They are busy all the time. They never rest or take a vacation. It would seem that they are in torment all the time (Rev. 20:10).

### E. Fourth, the weather.

It is warm all year long, some say it is hot. If you like a very hot and dry climate you will like this place. One resident said it was so dry that even a drop of water would be a welcome thing (Lk. 16:23-24).

## F. <u>Fifth</u>, the streets.

They are wide and well-traveled; most easy to find. The old saying of "you can't miss it" is true for almost everyone (Mt. 7:13).

### G. Sixth, reservations.

They are required, but you need next to nothing to get one, it is a place prepared for the devil and his angels (Mt. 25:41), but they will allow you to come too!

#### II. THE SECOND PIECE OF PROPERTY.

E. Fourth, the weather.

Ideal! It is so good it is hard to describe (1Cor. 2:6-9). All kinds of things going on; praise groups, heavenly choirs (cherubim and seraphim), etc. All the trees bring forth their fruit all year long (must be the water). Natural healing is the thing--everyone stays healthy with this natural diet (Rev. 22:1-2).

#### F. Fifth, the streets.
