- "My money."

We do, however, hear Him speak of

- "My Father" (Mt. 10:33),
- "My friends" (Jn. 15: 14),
- "My disciples" (Jn. 15:8),
- "My church" (Mt. 16:18),
- "My name" (Mt. 18:20),
- "My words" (Mk. 8:38),
- "My sheep" (Jn. 10:27), and
- "My joy" (Jn. 17:13).

It is significant that our Example thought more of spiritual possessions than of material ones.
