



### **The First Six Trumpets (8:1-9:21).**

The first trumpet (8:7) is: land disaster (1/3 destroyed)

The second trumpet (8:8,9) is: oceanic disaster (1/3 destroyed)

The third trumpet (8:10,11) is: fresh water disaster (1/3 destroyed)

The fourth trumpet (8:12) is: heavenly disaster (1/3 destroyed)

The message of the first four trumpets: a sampling of God's power to bring about repentance

The fifth trumpet (9:1-12) is: humans cannot temptation and suffering

The sixth trumpet (9:13-21) is: war is a warning sign to repent

The sad conclusion to the trumpets: mankind did not repent!

### **The Angel and the Little Book (10:1-11).**

The strong angel: a powerful and comforting servant of God and men

The bittersweet booklet: the message of the gospel is both sweet and bitter and we must preach both

### **The Two Witnesses (11:1-14).**

The two witnesses are: the Law and the Prophets testifying that Jesus is the Christ Destruction is coming -- repent!

### **The Seventh Trumpet (11:15-19).**

The vision says: Christ continues to reign supreme

The end of the seven trumpets means the end of the seven seals
