

INTRODUCTION.

- A. Welcome to our study of the book of Revelation using *Victory Assured!* as our guide.
- B. Purchasing the book is not necessary but will help deepen your understanding of the lessons.
- C. *Victory Assured!* is a thematic (or subject study) of the book of Revelation. *Victory Assured!* does not focus on the various details of the Revelation but rather stressed the main subjects and themes to help the reader gain the overall teachings of the book.
- D. Last week, Overcoming Materialism (18:1-24).
- E. This week, Overcoming at the Great Judgment (16:1-21; 19:1-21; 20:1-15).

OVERCOMING AT THE GREAT JUDGMENT

A. The Bowls (16:1-21).

Notice the similarities between the objects of wrath in the trumpets and bowls:

The Trumpets (1/3)

1. Third land
2. Third ocean
3. Third fresh water
4. Third heavens
5. Human sickness
6. War
7. Judgment to the saints

The Bowls (3/3)

- Destruction land.
- Destruction the sea.
- Destruction rivers & springs.
- Destruction the sun.
- Painful darkness.
- Destruction invading armies.
- Wicked are destroyed.

B. The Saints Rejoice (19:1-10).

1. Heaven rejoices because God is ready to vindicate the martyred saints.
2. The faithful are given fine linen, bright and clean, clothed with all of their wonderful righteous acts, befitting a saint.

C. The Sea and Earth Beasts are Destroyed (19:11-21).

The end of political and religious persecution.

The Lord is a conquering warrior:

1. eyes as a flame of fire, He wears many crowns.
2. robe dipped in blood, His name is the Word of God.
3. rides a white horse, He is Faithful and True.
4. Comes with a sword out of his mouth (Eph. 6:17).
5. Treads the wine press of God (judgment) (Rev. 14:14-20).

D. Satan is Defeated (20:1-15), Victory is Assured!

1. Devil will be bound, his power severely limited (20:3).
2. Satan will be released to be destroyed (20:7-10).
3. The unfaithful are condemned (20:11-15); victory to the saints!

CONCLUSION.

- A. Christians overcome at the judgment because judgment is against the sea beast, false prophet, and the devil.
- B. Judgment is in favor of the saints!
- C. With Jesus our Savior, the worthy Lamb, the Advocate, the conquering warrior, and the King of kings and Lord of Lords, victory is assured!
